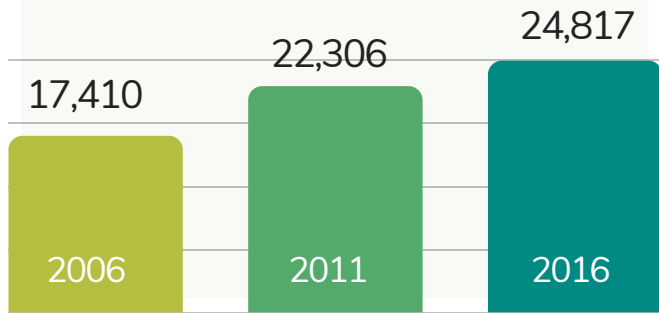


Homelessness in Victoria

24,817

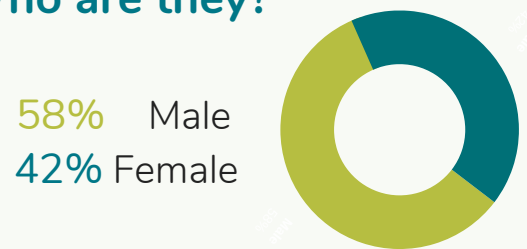
Victorians were experiencing homelessness (**21%** of the Australian homeless population). ¹

Where do they stay? ¹

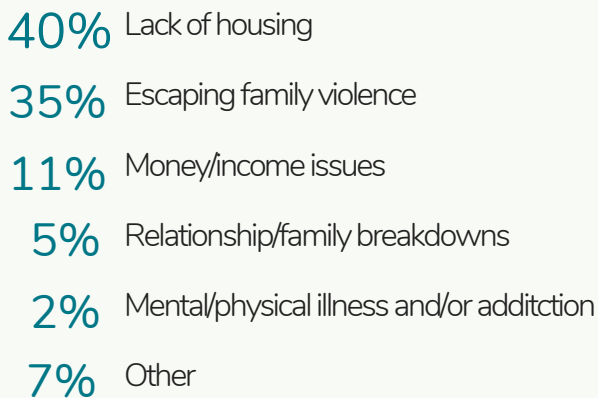


Every day **99** people (1 in 6 clients) are turned away from homelessness services due to a lack of housing & resources. ²

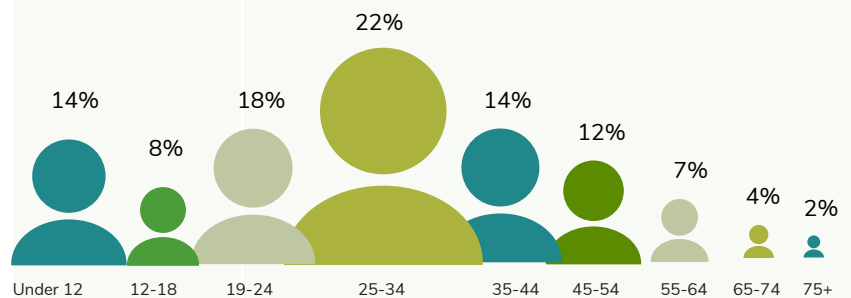
Who are they? ¹



Why are they experiencing homelessness? ³



Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander people are 4% of people experiencing homelessness, despite making up less than 1% of the Victorian population.



39% of Victorians counted as homeless on Census night were under 25 years old. ¹
