Homelessness in Ashwood

There are **355 people** without a home in Ashwood.

Homelessness affects **45 people** per 10,000, compared to the Victorian average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Ashwood **22nd in Victoria** out of 88 electorates.

Young people and homelessness in Ashwood

Young people without homes have different needs than adults. If they can't safely return home, they are likely to need support to maximise their potential, as well as a home they can afford on a very low income.

There are **141 young people** without a home in Ashwood – that's **91 young people** per 10,000, compared to the Victorian average of 64 per 10,000.
