

# Homelessness in Box Hill

There are **333 people** without a home in Box Hill.

Homelessness affects **42 people** per 10,000, compared to the Victorian average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Box Hill **27th in Victoria** out of 88 electorates.

## Young people and homelessness in Box Hill

Young people without homes have different needs than adults. If they can't safely return home, they are likely to need support to maximise their potential, as well as a home they can afford on a very low income.

There are **105 young people** without a home in Box Hill – that's **71 young people** per 10,000, compared to the Victorian average of 64 per 10,000.
