Homelessness in Bundoora

There are 328 people without a home in Bundoora.

Homelessness affects **46 people** per 10,000, compared to the Victorian average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Bundoora **28th in Victoria** out of 88 electorates.

Young people and homelessness in Bundoora

Young people without homes have different needs than adults. If they can't safely return home, they are likely to need support to maximise their potential, as well as a home they can afford on a very low income.

There are **101 young people** without a home in Bundoora – that's **74 young people** per 10,000, compared to the Victorian average of 64 per 10,000.
