Homelessness in Clarinda

There are 445 people without a home in Clarinda.

Homelessness affects **61 people** per 10,000, compared to the Victorian average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Clarinda **12th in Victoria** out of 88 electorates.

Young people and homelessness in Clarinda

Young people without homes have different needs than adults. If they can't safely return home, they are likely to need support to maximise their potential, as well as a home they can afford on a very low income.

There are **120 young people** without a home in Clarinda – that's **95 young people** per 10,000, compared to the Victorian average of 64 per 10,000.
