Homelessness in Greenvale

There are 383 people without a home in Greenvale.

Homelessness affects **56 people** per 10,000, compared to the Victorian average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Greenvale **19th in Victoria** out of 88 electorates.

Young people and homelessness in Greenvale

Young people without homes have different needs than adults. If they can't safely return home, they are likely to need support to maximise their potential, as well as a home they can afford on a very low income.

There are **108 young people** without a home in Greenvale – that's **83 young people** per 10,000, compared to the Victorian average of 64 per 10,000.
