Homelessness in Kororoit

There are **383 people** without a home in Kororoit.

Homelessness affects **52 people** per 10,000, compared to the Victorian average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Kororoit **18th in Victoria** out of 88 electorates.

Young people and homelessness in Kororoit

Young people without homes have different needs than adults. If they can't safely return home, they are likely to need support to maximise their potential, as well as a home they can afford on a very low income.

There are **117 young people** without a home in Kororoit – that's **93 young people** per 10,000, compared to the Victorian average of 64 per 10,000.
