

Homelessness in Laverton

There are **576 people** without a home in Laverton.

Homelessness affects **74 people** per 10,000, compared to the Victorian average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Laverton **8th in Victoria** out of 88 electorates.

Young people and homelessness in Laverton

Young people without homes have different needs than adults. If they can't safely return home, they are likely to need support to maximise their potential, as well as a home they can afford on a very low income.

There are **169 young people** without a home in Laverton – that's **132 young people** per 10,000, compared to the Victorian average of 64 per 10,000.
