Homelessness in Mulgrave

There are **512 people** without a home in Mulgrave.

Homelessness affects **68 people** per 10,000, compared to the Victorian average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Mulgrave **10th in Victoria** out of 88 electorates.

Young people and homelessness in Mulgrave

Young people without homes have different needs than adults. If they can't safely return home, they are likely to need support to maximise their potential, as well as a home they can afford on a very low income.

There are **140 young people** without a home in Mulgrave – that's **115 young people** per 10,000, compared to the Victorian average of 64 per 10,000.
