# Homelessness in Narre Warren South

There are 426 people without a home in Narre Warren South.

Homelessness affects **50 people** per 10,000, compared to the Victorian average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Narre Warren South **15th in Victoria** out of 88 electorates.

## Young people and homelessness in Narre Warren South

Young people without homes have different needs than adults. If they can't safely return home, they are likely to need support to maximise their potential, as well as a home they can afford on a very low income.

There are **158 young people** without a home in Narre Warren South – that's **99 young people** per 10,000, compared to the Victorian average of 64 per 10,000.
