

Homelessness in Oakleigh

There are **633 people** without a home in Oakleigh.

Homelessness affects **71 people** per 10,000, compared to the Victorian average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Oakleigh **6th in Victoria** out of 88 electorates.

Young people and homelessness in Oakleigh

Young people without homes have different needs than adults. If they can't safely return home, they are likely to need support to maximise their potential, as well as a home they can afford on a very low income.

There are **247 young people** without a home in Oakleigh – that's **127 young people** per 10,000, compared to the Victorian average of 64 per 10,000.
