Homelessness in Pascoe Vale

There are 278 people without a home in Pascoe Vale.

Homelessness affects **42 people** per 10,000, compared to the Victorian average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Pascoe Vale **31st in Victoria** out of 88 electorates.

Young people and homelessness in Pascoe Vale

Young people without homes have different needs than adults. If they can't safely return home, they are likely to need support to maximise their potential, as well as a home they can afford on a very low income.

There are **100 young people** without a home in Pascoe Vale – that's **103 young people** per 10,000, compared to the Victorian average of 64 per 10,000.
