

Homelessness in Shepparton

There are **372 people** without a home in Shepparton.

Homelessness affects **54 people** per 10,000, compared to the Victorian average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Shepparton **21st in Victoria** out of 88 electorates.

Young people and homelessness in Shepparton

Young people without homes have different needs than adults. If they can't safely return home, they are likely to need support to maximise their potential, as well as a home they can afford on a very low income.

There are **79 young people** without a home in Shepparton – that's **70 young people** per 10,000, compared to the Victorian average of 64 per 10,000.
