

Homelessness in Warrandyte

There are **141 people** without a home in Warrandyte.

Homelessness affects **20 people** per 10,000, compared to the Victorian average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Warrandyte **69th in Victoria** out of 88 electorates.

Young people and homelessness in Warrandyte

Young people without homes have different needs than adults. If they can't safely return home, they are likely to need support to maximise their potential, as well as a home they can afford on a very low income.

There are **38 young people** without a home in Warrandyte – that's **31 young people** per 10,000, compared to the Victorian average of 64 per 10,000.
