## Homelessness in Ashwood

There are 622 people without a home in Ashwood on any given night.

Homelessness affects **77 people per 10,000** compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Ashwood **11th out of 88** Victorian electorates.

## **Tracking progress**

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has increased by 75.3% in Ashwood.

In 2016, there were 355 people without a home, ranking Ashwood 22nd out of 88 Victorian electorates.
