Homelessness in Bendigo West

There are 263 people without a home in Bendigo West on any given night.

Homelessness affects 40 people per 10,000 compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Bendigo West 46th out of 88 Victorian electorates.

Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has increased by 38.3% in Bendigo West.

In 2016, there were 190 people without a home, ranking Bendigo West 48th out of 88 Victorian electorates.
