Homelessness in Box Hill

There are 628 people without a home in Box Hill on any given night.

Homelessness affects **74 people per 10,000** compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Box Hill **9th out of 88** Victorian electorates.

Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has increased by 88.7% in Box Hill.

In 2016, there were 333 people without a home, ranking Box Hill 27th out of 88 Victorian electorates.
