Homelessness in Broadmeadows

There are 638 people without a home in Broadmeadows on any given night.

Homelessness affects 80 people per 10,000 compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Broadmeadows 8th out of 88 Victorian electorates.

Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has increased by 15.4% in Broadmeadows.

In 2016, there were 553 people without a home, ranking Broadmeadows 9th out of 88 Victorian electorates.
