Homelessness in Bulleen

There are 137 people without a home in Bulleen on any given night.

Homelessness affects 19 people per 10,000 compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Bulleen 73rd out of 88 Victorian electorates.

Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has increased by 5.3% in Bulleen.

In 2016, there were 130 people without a home, ranking Bulleen 71st out of 88 Victorian electorates.
