

Homelessness in Bundoora

There are **430 people** without a home in Bundoora on any given night.

Homelessness affects **61 people per 10,000** compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Bundoora **26th out of 88** Victorian electorates.

Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has increased by 31.1% in Bundoora.

In 2016, there were 328 people without a home, ranking Bundoora 28th out of 88 Victorian electorates.
