

Homelessness in Clarinda

There are **528 people** without a home in Clarinda on any given night.

Homelessness affects **72 people per 10,000** compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Clarinda **15th out of 88** Victorian electorates.

Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has increased by 18.6% in Clarinda.

In 2016, there were 445 people without a home, ranking Clarinda 12th out of 88 Victorian electorates.
