Homelessness in Dandenong

There are 1719 people without a home in Dandenong on any given night.

Homelessness affects 192 people per 10,000 compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Dandenong 1st out of 88 Victorian electorates.

Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has increased by 53.7% in Dandenong.

In 2016, there were 1118 people without a home, ranking Dandenong 2nd out of 88 Victorian electorates.
