

Homelessness in Euroa

There are **179 people** without a home in Euroa on any given night.

Homelessness affects **28 people per 10,000** compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Euroa **63rd out of 88** Victorian electorates.

Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has decreased by 2.6% in Euroa.

In 2016, there were 184 people without a home, ranking Euroa 53rd out of 88 Victorian electorates.
