Homelessness in Evelyn

There are 234 people without a home in Evelyn on any given night.

Homelessness affects 35 people per 10,000 compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Evelyn 51st out of 88 Victorian electorates.

Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has increased by 62.4% in Evelyn.

In 2016, there were 144 people without a home, ranking Evelyn 68th out of 88 Victorian electorates.
