Homelessness in Frankston

There are 682 people without a home in Frankston on any given night.

Homelessness affects 101 people per 10,000 compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Frankston 7th out of 88 Victorian electorates.

Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has increased by 61.6% in Frankston.

In 2016, there were 422 people without a home, ranking Frankston 17th out of 88 Victorian electorates.
