## Homelessness in Gippsland South

There are 153 people without a home in Gippsland South on any given night.

Homelessness affects 23 people per 10,000 compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Gippsland South 70th out of 88 Victorian electorates.

## **Tracking progress**

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has increased by 33.6% in Gippsland South.

In 2016, there were 114 people without a home, ranking Gippsland South 78th out of 88 Victorian electorates.
