

# Homelessness in Glen Waverley

There are **287 people** without a home in Glen Waverley on any given night.

Homelessness affects **35 people per 10,000** compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Glen Waverley **43rd out of 88** Victorian electorates.

## Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

**Since the last Census, homelessness has increased by 36.1% in Glen Waverley.**

In 2016, there were 211 people without a home, ranking Glen Waverley 42nd out of 88 Victorian electorates.
