

Homelessness in Greenvale

There are **425 people** without a home in Greenvale on any given night.

Homelessness affects **55 people per 10,000** compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Greenvale **27th out of 88** Victorian electorates.

Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has increased by 11.1% in Greenvale.

In 2016, there were 383 people without a home, ranking Greenvale 19th out of 88 Victorian electorates.
