

Homelessness in Ivanhoe

There are **319 people** without a home in Ivanhoe on any given night.

Homelessness affects **48 people per 10,000** compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Ivanhoe **39th out of 88** Victorian electorates.

Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has increased by 73.5% in Ivanhoe.

In 2016, there were 184 people without a home, ranking Ivanhoe 52nd out of 88 Victorian electorates.
