

Homelessness in Kororoit

There are **431 people** without a home in Kororoit on any given night.

Homelessness affects **49 people per 10,000** compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Kororoit **25th out of 88** Victorian electorates.

Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has increased by 12.6% in Kororoit.

In 2016, there were 383 people without a home, ranking Kororoit 18th out of 88 Victorian electorates.
