Homelessness in Lowan

There are 218 people without a home in Lowan on any given night.

Homelessness affects 32 people per 10,000 compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Lowan 52nd out of 88 Victorian electorates.

Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has increased by 70.1% in Lowan.

In 2016, there were 128 people without a home, ranking Lowan 72nd out of 88 Victorian electorates.
