## Homelessness in Macedon

There are 115 people without a home in Macedon on any given night.

Homelessness affects 20 people per 10,000 compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Macedon 81st out of 88 Victorian electorates.

## **Tracking progress**

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has increased by 31.4% in Macedon.

In 2016, there were 87 people without a home, ranking Macedon 85th out of 88 Victorian electorates.
