

# Homelessness in Mildura

There are **516 people** without a home in Mildura on any given night.

Homelessness affects **74 people per 10,000** compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Mildura **16th out of 88** Victorian electorates.

## Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

**Since the last Census, homelessness has increased by 95.4% in Mildura.**

In 2016, there were 264 people without a home, ranking Mildura 35th out of 88 Victorian electorates.
