Homelessness in Mill Park

There are 180 people without a home in Mill Park on any given night.

Homelessness affects **26 people per 10,000** compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Mill Park **62nd out of 88** Victorian electorates.

Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has increased by 31.4% in Mill Park.

In 2016, there were 137 people without a home, ranking Mill Park 70th out of 88 Victorian electorates.
