Homelessness in Monbulk

There are 110 people without a home in Monbulk on any given night.

Homelessness affects 16 people per 10,000 compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Monbulk 83rd out of 88 Victorian electorates.

Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has decreased by 4.4% in Monbulk.

In 2016, there were 115 people without a home, ranking Monbulk 77th out of 88 Victorian electorates.
