

Homelessness in Mordialloc

There are **169 people** without a home in Mordialloc on any given night.

Homelessness affects **24 people per 10,000** compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Mordialloc **66th out of 88** Victorian electorates.

Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has decreased by 8.9% in Mordialloc.

In 2016, there were 185 people without a home, ranking Mordialloc 50th out of 88 Victorian electorates.
