Homelessness in Mornington

There are 126 people without a home in Mornington on any given night.

Homelessness affects 20 people per 10,000 compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Mornington 77th out of 88 Victorian electorates.

Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has increased by 22.4% in Mornington.

In 2016, there were 103 people without a home, ranking Mornington 81st out of 88 Victorian electorates.
