Homelessness in Morwell

There are 377 people without a home in Morwell on any given night.

Homelessness affects 52 people per 10,000 compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Morwell 30th out of 88 Victorian electorates.

Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has increased by 83.6% in Morwell.

In 2016, there were 205 people without a home, ranking Morwell 43rd out of 88 Victorian electorates.
