Homelessness in Mulgrave

There are 623 people without a home in Mulgrave on any given night.

Homelessness affects 82 people per 10,000 compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Mulgrave 10th out of 88 Victorian electorates.

Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has increased by 21.7% in Mulgrave.

In 2016, there were 512 people without a home, ranking Mulgrave 10th out of 88 Victorian electorates.
