## Homelessness in Murray Plains

There are 193 people without a home in Murray Plains on any given night.

Homelessness affects 30 people per 10,000 compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Murray Plains 58th out of 88 Victorian electorates.

## **Tracking progress**

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has increased by 21.6% in Murray Plains.

In 2016, there were 159 people without a home, ranking Murray Plains 64th out of 88 Victorian electorates.
