

# Homelessness in Narracan

There are **163 people** without a home in Narracan on any given night.

Homelessness affects **25 people per 10,000** compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Narracan **68th out of 88** Victorian electorates.

## Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

**Since the last Census, homelessness has increased by 38.1% in Narracan.**

In 2016, there were 118 people without a home, ranking Narracan 76th out of 88 Victorian electorates.
