Homelessness in Narracan

There are 163 people without a home in Narracan on any given night.

Homelessness affects **25 people per 10,000** compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Narracan **68th out of 88** Victorian electorates.

Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has increased by 38.1% in Narracan.

In 2016, there were 118 people without a home, ranking Narracan 76th out of 88 Victorian electorates.
