

# Homelessness in Narre Warren North

There are **496 people** without a home in Narre Warren North on any given night.

Homelessness affects **63 people per 10,000** compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Narre Warren North **19th out of 88** Victorian electorates.

## Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

**Since the last Census, homelessness has increased by 47.0% in Narre Warren North.**

In 2016, there were 337 people without a home, ranking Narre Warren North 25th out of 88 Victorian electorates.
