

# Homelessness in Narre Warren South

There are **421 people** without a home in Narre Warren South on any given night.

Homelessness affects **46 people per 10,000** compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Narre Warren South **28th out of 88** Victorian electorates.

## Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

**Since the last Census, homelessness has decreased by 1.1% in Narre Warren South.**

In 2016, there were 426 people without a home, ranking Narre Warren South 15th out of 88 Victorian electorates.
