Homelessness in Narre Warren South

There are 421 people without a home in Narre Warren South on any given night.

Homelessness affects 46 people per 10,000 compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Narre Warren South 28th out of 88 Victorian electorates.

Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has decreased by 1.1% in Narre Warren South.

In 2016, there were 426 people without a home, ranking Narre Warren South 15th out of 88 Victorian electorates.
