Homelessness in Nepean

There are 192 people without a home in Nepean on any given night.

Homelessness affects 31 people per 10,000 compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Nepean 59th out of 88 Victorian electorates.

Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has increased by 59.1% in Nepean.

In 2016, there were 121 people without a home, ranking Nepean 74th out of 88 Victorian electorates.
