Homelessness in Niddrie

There are 84 people without a home in Niddrie on any given night.

Homelessness affects 12 people per 10,000 compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Niddrie 85th out of 88 Victorian electorates.

Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has decreased by 22.5% in Niddrie.

In 2016, there were 108 people without a home, ranking Niddrie 80th out of 88 Victorian electorates.
