Homelessness in Northcote

There are 299 people without a home in Northcote on any given night.

Homelessness affects 44 people per 10,000 compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Northcote 42nd out of 88 Victorian electorates.

Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has decreased by 11.3% in Northcote.

In 2016, there were 337 people without a home, ranking Northcote 26th out of 88 Victorian electorates.
