Homelessness in Ovens Valley

There are 212 people without a home in Ovens Valley on any given night.

Homelessness affects 33 people per 10,000 compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Ovens Valley 55th out of 88 Victorian electorates.

Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has increased by 38.2% in Ovens Valley.

In 2016, there were 153 people without a home, ranking Ovens Valley 65th out of 88 Victorian electorates.
