Homelessness in Pakenham

There are 259 people without a home in Pakenham on any given night.

Homelessness affects 34 people per 10,000 compared to the state average of 42 per 10,000 – ranking Pakenham 47th out of 88 Victorian electorates.

Tracking progress

In March 2023, the ABS released its Estimating Homelessness report from the 2021 Census, allowing us to compare how homelessness has changed since 2016.

Since the last Census, homelessness has increased by 111.8% in Pakenham.

In 2016, there were 122 people without a home, ranking Pakenham 73rd out of 88 Victorian electorates.
